INITIAL INFORMATION

This report is in reference to a school survey which was conducted at the request of the Transportation Coordinator of the School District of Hartland to check for unusual hazardous conditions existing in and around North Shore Middle School. The main area of concern was the crosswalk area on N Shore Dr.

INITIAL OBSERVATIONS

Upon receiving this assignment I compiled information regarding the geographical location and traffic patterns. The speed limit in the area is posted at 45 MPH and 15 MPH in the designated school zone. It should be noted that the area is heavily traveled by motorists between the hours of 0630 hours and 1800 hours. It should also be noted that the area is equipped with sidewalks on the north side of N Shore Dr. While approaching the school there are highly visible fluorescent yellow/green signs to alert drivers that students may be in the

area. While traveling WB there is a flashing sign to alert drivers that pedestrians may be in the crosswalk area.

BEFORE SCHOOL OBSERVATION

While observing traffic during the before school hours, it should be noted there was minimal student foot or bicycle traffic. I did observe that vehicles failed to slow while approaching the school zone when students approached the crosswalk area.

I also observed that EB traffic would backup on N Shore Dr. while drivers attempted to enter onto the school grounds. This was a hazard due to EB traffic had little time to react after cresting a hill. It should be noted that the school entrance is at the bottom of the hill.

AFTER SCHOOL OBSERVATIONS

While observing student foot traffic during the after-school hours, it should be noted that students again had to contend with a high volume of motorists if they were to attempt to use the crosswalk. I also observed the same hazard with EB traffic having little time to react to the vehicles stopped on N Shore Dr. attempting to enter onto school grounds.

CONCERNS

The crest of the hill on N Shore Dr., west of the school creates a hazard due to there is limited time for EB vehicle traffic to react to vehicles stopped on the road attempting to enter the school grounds.

PROVIDED SAFETY MEASURES

Provided safety measures consisted of fluorescent yellow/ green signs and flashing signs in the crosswalk approach. Posted 45 MPH speed signs and 15MPH school zone when students are present.

CONCLUSION

During my observation I did not observe a large amount of student foot or bicycle traffic crossing N Shore Dr. The weather conditions during this study consisted of one day with rain and two days with cooler temperatures.

Flashing signage may be affective if placed further W of the school on N Shore

Dr. in attempt to alleviate the congestion with vehicles attempting to enter onto school grounds after cresting the hill.

Upon resurfacing EB N Shore Dr. it may be beneficial to extent the passing lane farther W when approaching the school to allow for drivers to avoid congestion and avoid the heavy breaking.

SYNOPSIS

This report is in reference to a school bus eligibility study requested by the Hartland/Lakeside School District. The areas of focus were the River Reserve subdivision and the area of Old North Shore Dr as they relate to North Shore Middle School, Hartland Elementary School North and Hartland Elementary School South. Only one area will not receive the unusually hazardous designation - River Reserve north of CTH KE as it relates to North Shore Middle School. No follow up is needed.

RIVER RESERVE SOUTH OF CTH KE

This area will receive the unusually hazardous designation. There is not sidewalk access to any of the schools and children would have to cross CTH KE or Maple Ave without a sidewalk or a crosswalk.

RIVER RESERVE NORTH OF CTH KE

This area will receive the unusually hazardous designation as it relates to the two elementary schools (Hartland North and South). Many students attending Hartland South would be required to cross Maple Ave at Lindenwood Dr without a crosswalk and there is not a sidewalk leading to the school once across the intersection. Children attending Hartland North would have to access the same intersection and to use the sidewalk on Maple Ave they would have to cross that

intersection.

As this area relates to North Shore Middle School, it will not receive the unusually hazardous designation. There is sidewalk access throughout the subdivision and there is a walking path that leads to the four way stop at Maple Ave and CTH KE. There is a marked crosswalk at this intersection and the sidewalk along CTH KE leads all the way to the middle school.

OLD NORTH SHORE RD

All areas in the vicinity of Old North Shore Rd, including, but not limited to, Taylor's Woods Rd, Conservancy Dr, Lakeside Rd and Yorkshire Terrace, will receive the unusually hazardous designation for North Shore Middle School and Hartland South. These areas do not have a sidewalk.

SYNOPSIS

This report is in reference to a school bus eligibility study I completed at the request of the Hartland-Lakeside school district. Specific areas of interest included the general area of CTH KE near Glacier Rd, Capitol Dr and Lisbon Rd. Also observed was the downtown Hartland area near the intersection of Capitol Dr and Cottonwood Ave. No follow up is needed.

On Monday, March 25, 2024, I was on duty as a Waukesha County Deputy assigned to the 9101 district in marked squad 256.

OVERVIEW

I was contacted via email by Amy Holley, the Director of Business Services for the Hartland-Lakeside School District. Holley requested a school bus eligibility study for several areas with respect to Hartland Elementary School North and South. The specific areas are as follows -

Hartland South:

- Intersection of Glacier Rd & CTH KE including railroad tracks
- Glacier Rd East to Somerset Ln

Hartland North:

- Lisbon Ave from Lake Country Meadow Subdivision East to CTH KE
- Capitol Dr from Rustic Ln East to CTH KE - encompassing Willow Brook Farms Subdivision
- Intersection of Capitol Dr/North Ave/Hill St/Cottonwood Ave in the Village of Hartland
- Intersection of Cottonwood Ave/Haight Dr
- Railroad tracks on Cottonwood Ave

HARTLAND SOUTH

The intersection of Glacier Rd/CTH KE and the area east to Somerset Ln will receive the unusually hazardous designation due to the lack of sidewalks.

HARTLAND NORTH

Lisbon Ave from the Lake Country Meadow subdivision east to CTH KE will receive the unusually hazardous designation due to the lack of sidewalks.

Capitol Dr from Rustic Ln to CTH KE will receive the unusually hazardous designation due to the lack of sidewalks.

The intersection of Capitol Dr/North Ave/Hill St/Cottonwood Ave will not receive the unusually hazardous designation. The intersection has sidewalks and marked crosswalks.

The intersection of Cottonwood Ave/Haight Dr will not receive the unusually hazardous designation. The intersection has sidewalks and marked crosswalks.

The railroad crossing on Cottonwood Ave near Pawling Ave will not receive the unusually hazardous designation. The railroad crossing is clearly marked and there are sidewalks.
